The regular meeting of the Riverside Township Committee was held on the above date at the Riverside Township Municipal Building with the following members present: Messrs. Prisco, Van Meter, Mrs. Hatcher and Mr. Conard along with Township Administrator Meghan Jack, Municipal Clerk Susan M. Dydek, and Solicitor Saponaro. Mr. Polino was absent.

Motion made by Mrs. Hatcher, seconded by Mr. Van Meter to excuse Mr. Polino's absence. (Mr. Polino is currently serving in the Armed Forces) **carried.**

Motion made by Mrs. Hatcher and Mr. Prisco that the following minutes be approved as written: the Work Session Meeting of December 19, 2011, the Regular Meeting of December 19, 2011, the Closed Session Meeting of December 19, 2011 and the Reorganization Meeting of January 1, 2012 be approved as written carried.

Mayor Conard opened the meeting to the public for agenda items only.

Hearing nothing from the public, **motion made by Mr. Van Meter and Mrs. Hatcher to close Public Portion (Agenda Items Only) carried.**

Mayor Conard questioned who was appointed as the Conflict Prosecutor and Conflict Public Defender. Attorney Teresa Ganim stated that it was her understanding that the Conflict Prosecutor is Dean Buono and if needed a second it would be Jerry Trainer; for Conflict Public Defender it would be Lance Forbes and Jim Grace. Municipal Clerk Dydek stated that the names that Attorney Ganim stated are not the same names that are in the Resolutions. Administrator Jack stated that those names were not on the list that was given by the Municipal Court. Administrator Jack stated that Dean Buono is listed on the Resolution as the Conflict Prosecutor; however, Jerry Trainer is not. Also, the following people are named in the Resolution for Conflict Prosecutors: Lance Forbes, James Frattorini, F.S. Gurk, Robert Barth, Richard Isolda and Francis Galdo. Municipal Clerk stated that the Committee if they wanted to, they could make a motion to rescind Resolutions 2012-8A and 2012-9A and table them for the next meeting. **Mrs. Hatcher made a motion to rescind Resolutions 2012-8A and 2012-9A. 
WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Riverside ("Township") is dedicated to improving and preserving the Downtown Business District; and

RESOLUTION 2012-#28
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN RIVERSIDE
TOWNSHIP AND DELRAN TOWNSHIP FOR CERTIFIED RECYCLING
PROFESSIONAL (CRP) TO PREPARE ANNUAL RECYCLING TONNAGE
REPORT

Beginning 2012, each New Jersey municipality is required by the Recycling Enhancement Act (REA) to have mandatory Annual Recycling Tonnage Reports approved and "signed" by a Certified Recycling Professional (hereinafter "CRP"). Recycling Tonnage Reports will be submitted via email to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) utilizing a spreadsheet compatible with the Microsoft Excel structure provided by the Department.

THIS AGREEMENT by and between Riverside Township, a municipal body politic having its offices at 237 S. Pavilion Avenue, Riverside, New Jersey, 08075, and Delran Township, a municipal body politic having its offices located at 900 Chester Avenue, Delran, New Jersey, 08075 (hereinafter "Riverside" and "Delran"), is dated this 18th day of January, 2012.

WHEREAS, both Riverside and Delran, by ordinance, have duly enacted a recycling plan for all recyclable materials as designated by the Burlington County Solid Waste Management Plan and amendments thereto and:

WHEREAS, Riverside is desirous of retaining CRP services of Delran for the submission of said Annual Recycling Tonnage Report; and

WHEREAS, the award of this contract to the CRP of Delran pursuant to N.J.S.A. Section 13:1E-99.14 is an exception to the bidding requirements as set forth in the "Local Public Contracts Law" pursuant to N.J.S.A. Section 40A:11-5(2), and the Board of Freeholders for Burlington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, mutual benefits

and covenants hereinafter set forth, Riverside and Delran make this agreement.


1. Riverside shall retain the services of Delran for a CRP that will be responsible for submitting the mandatory annual municipal recycling tonnage report, as provided in the Burlington County Solid Waste Management Plan, and with the State NJDEP.
2. It is understood that the responsibility for the accuracy of all tonnage and materials reported lies with the designated preparer of the Recycling Tonnage Report, regardless if it is a municipal representative, or the aforementioned CRP. Riverside designates Meghan Jack as the preparer of the report. The report preparer is responsible should the NJDEP audit the report submittal.
3. It is Riverside's responsibility to retain the appropriate documentation for five years in the event of a field review.
4. Either party reserves the right to reasonably amend the specifications of this Agreement by giving thirty (30) day written notification to the other parties of any changes thereto.
5. If applicable, shall pay a fee for the CRP's service to the Municipality. Riverside will pay all invoices within thirty (30) days.
6. This agreement is the entire agreement between Riverside and Delran and supersedes all previous agreements and discussions. Any amendments hereto must be in writing and must be duly executed by Riverside and Delran to become effective.

- 7. This Agreement will be entirely performed within the State of New Jersey and it shall be construed in accordance with the laws thereof.
- 8. If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void, ultravires, or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.





COMMITTEE REPORTS:**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY:**

Chief Tursi reported the Police Activity for December 2011: Investigations – 99, Adult Arrests Total – 91, Motor Vehicle Summons – 114, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 11, Juvenile Charges – 9, Curfew Violations – 0, Protective Custody – 0, Domestic Violence Cases – 13, Summons for False Alarms – 0, False Alarm Calls - 16. Chief Tursi also reported the various training that the Officers attended, the various programs that the officers and the Chief participated in, and various awards and commendations that the police officers received. A copy of the report is on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.

Mrs. Hatcher commended Lieutenant Dave Jaensch and Patrolman Sean Nolan for their undercover work.

Mayor Conard reported the Delran Emergency Squad Activity for December 2011: Medical Emergencies – 72, Motor Vehicle Accidents – 2, Fire Stand Bys – 0, Non Emergency Transports – 3, Patients transported to the hospital – 64 and Patients refused treatment and transportation – 10.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS:

Mrs. Hatcher stated that Mr. March will give the report. Mr. March reported that the Public Works Department has been doing the fall leaf collection and is working on their last pass around the Town. Leaf collection has begun in all Township owned parks, lots and ball fields. Road maintenance was performed. Christmas tree pick up began on January 9, 2012 and will continue until February 3rd 2012. The activities for January 2012 were reported. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

Mr. Prisco questioned when the Public Works yard will be open. Mr. March stated that it will be open on January 28, 2012.

Mrs. Hatcher commended the Public Works Department for cleaning the park.

DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND FINANCE:

Mr. Van Meter reported that the first quarter property tax payments will be due on February 1, 2012 and there is a ten day grace period through February 10, 2012. Also, all unpaid municipal charges or property taxes that were not paid by December 31, 2011 will be subject to the 2012 Tax Sale on April 5, 2012.

DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION:

Mr. Prisco reported that on Sunday January 22, 2012 the Riverside Youth Athletic League will be holding a fund raiser at the Riverside High School at noon.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EVENTS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:

Mrs. Hatcher reported that although it was not a Township event, that there was a clothes swap at Riverside Turners and it was a huge success; and there will be another one scheduled in the future. Mrs. Hatcher stated that she is having a problem with the Township sign and that it needs maintenance.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor Ganim stated that Mr. Saponaro will be available on Monday at 9:00am to address any concerns.

CLERK – COLLECTOR’S REPORT:

Municipal Clerk/Deputy Tax Collector Dydek reported that the Real Estate Tax Collection Status as follows: Prior Year – 96.79%, Current Year – 12.38% and Next Year – 0.00%.

Municipal Clerk Dydek reported that she submitted a written report to the Committee. Mrs. Dydek reported that 270 dog licenses have been issued and 23 cat licenses have been issued. Licenses should be procured by January 31, 2012 to avoid the \$15.00 late fee. Rabies certificates must be good through November 1, 2012 to obtain a dog license. The free rabies clinic was held on Saturday January 7, 2012.

ENGINEER’S REPORT:

Mayor Conard asked the Committee if there were any questions regarding the Engineer’s Report that was submitted. No questions were presented. A copy of the report is on file in the Municipal Clerk’s office.

ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT:

Administrator Jack reported that the Township has a grant for housing rehabilitation and the requirements to participate in this grant is based off of a qualifying income. Also the budget meetings will be upcoming and future grants will be discussed.

RABIES CLINIC REPORT:

Mayor Conard asked the Committee if there were any questions regarding the Rabies Clinic Report that was submitted. No questions were presented. A copy of the report is on file in the Liaison to the Board of Health’s office.

RENTAL INSPECTOR’S REPORT:

The Rental Inspector’s report has been distributed. Mayor Conard questioned if the Committee had any inquiries. No inquiries were presented. The report is on file in the Municipal Clerk’s Office.


PUBLIC PORTION
