On a personal note, Mr. Greiner commended the Public Works Department on their leaf collection and snow removal. - 2) Ms. Christine Martinez 230 Cleveland Avenue stated her concerns regarding the roach problem on the adjoining house next to hers. Ms. Martinez also stated her concerns with the overcrowding in this house. The residents had a pig roast on New Year's Eve and there is still pig bones, ears and other body parts in the back yard.
- 3) Mr. Carlos Martinez 230 Cleveland Avenue Mr. Martinez stated that they neighbors put their shoes on the roof, their door bangs open and closed 24 hours a day. Mr. Martinez stated that he has tried to talk to the neighbors but there is no improvement.
