Dear Tax Collector.

The Division of Taxation has begun mailing 2022 Senior Freeze (Property Tax Reimbursement) checks to applicants who filed before May 1, 2023. The deadline for 2022 applications is October 31, 2023.

We will mail checks to qualified applicants as follows:

Application filed:

Before May 1, 2023 May 1 – June 1, 2023 June 2 – September 1, 2023 September 2 – October 31, 2023

Checks will be issued on or before:

July 15, 2023 September 1, 2023 November 1, 2023 December 1, 2023

Only applicants whose 2022 income did not exceed \$99,735 are eligible to receive a reimbursement payment, provided they met all the other requirements. Homeowners who have not yet filed applications may ask for your help in completing Forms PTR-1A and PTR-2A – the verification forms that document the amount of property taxes due and paid.

You may receive inquiries from homeowners regarding reimbursement checks or notices they receive from us.
