Dewatered sludge [25 yds] were removed by the Seaside Waste Services Company for composting at the County facility.
- 2. Trouble log for February is attached.
- 3. Weekly collection system checks were performed in February.
- 4. No measurements were taking for the Secondary Digester Cover tilt during this reporting period. The Secondary Digester is not operating as designed. The Secondary Digester Dome requires methane gas produced in the Primary Digester for the secondary roof to float correctly.
- 5. Still working on collecting data for the Nitrification tower upgrades.
- 6. Jet Vac repairs/maintenance were done by Timmerman.
- 7. Carter Pump is back in service. Replaced check valve for the pump also.
