In connection with the referenced project we have attached Change Order No. 2 for Township execution

Change Order No. 2 is for drainage pipe replacements to assist with flood mitigation. More specifically, we have learned much about the existing drainage system in the past month with investigations performed by Mike Kokes and his engineering team, and Black Rock's work installing new inlets on Second Street, which included video attempts by the Sewerage Authority.

Based on what we have learned and the fact that Second Street is undergoing significant improvements, we recommend that the existing metal drainage trunkline pipes be replaced within the work zone on Second Street between Fairview Street and Delaware Avenue and at the Delaware Avenue intersection.

We offer the following summary:

RESOLUTION 2024 – #123

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE REVOCATION OF THE LANDLORD LICENSE ISSUED FOR PROPERTIES KNOWN AS 210 KOSSUTH STREET, 709 BRIDGEBORO STREET, 728 FILMORE STREET, 507 BEM STREET, 20 W. HANCOCK STREET, AND 224 E. WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the Township of Riverside (the "Township") recognizes the value of ensuring safe and quality housing for residents of the Township who rent their homes from landlords; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to ensure that property owners and landlords are abiding by the standards set forth by the Code of the Township of Riverside, the Township enacted Ordinance No. 2022-#14 (the "Ordinance"), which sets forth a procedure for the licensing of landlords; and

WHEREAS, in addition to setting forth standards for the licensing of landlords, the Ordinance also establishes a procedure whereby a landlord's license to rent property can be revoked; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance, should the Township seek to revoke a landlord's license, the Township is obligated to conduct a hearing, with such hearing either being before Township Committee or before a Hearing Officer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance, if the Township elects to hold such a hearing before a hearing officer, the hearing officer is required to transmit their findings and conclusions to Township Committee and Township Committee may then accept, reject, or modify the recommendations of the hearing officer; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2024 a hearing was held concerning the revocation of the landlord license for a property owner, for properties addressed as 210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street, and 224 E. Washington Avenue; and

WHEREAS, in a report from the hearing officer, dated. November 13, 2024, it is stated that "It is therefore recommended that the penalty for the repeated violations of the Township Code with respect to the properties owned by the subject landlord,..., with respect to the properties at 210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street and 224 E. Washington Avenue, is that the license of [the property owner] to rent these properties should be **revoked**; and

WHEREAS, in this same report from the hearing officer, it is stated "It is recommended that a <u>fine</u> of \$2000 for each of the six properties or rental units (210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street and 224 E. Washington Avenue) be assessed against the property owner.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

- The Township Committee of the Township of Riverside accepts the findings of the hearing officer and hereby revokes the license of the property owner to rent properties known as 210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street and 224 E. Washington Avenue.
- 2. The Township Committee of the Township of Riverside accepts the findings of the hearing officer and hereby issues a fine in the amount of \$2000 for each of the above six properties to be assessed against the property owner.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-#14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVERSIDE TO REVISE CHAPTER 337 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO ADDRESS LANDLORD LICENSING AND REGISTRATION

WHEREAS, the Township of Riverside (the "Township") previously adopted Ordinance No. 2008-14 regarding Rental Properties and amended that Ordinance in its entirety by Ordinance No. 2016-06, and

WHEREAS, since that time, the Township has determined that there is a need to update and revise Chapter 337 regarding Rental Properties of the Township Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Riverside, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 337 of the Township Code is updated/revised as indicated in the attached pages.

Dydek, RMC, Riverside Township Clerk, hereby certify that the foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted by the Riverside Township Committee of the Township of Riverside, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, at their Regular Meeting after a Public Hearing held on the 21st day of November, 2022.

Chapter 337 of the Township Code is amended as follows:

§ 337-1. **Definitions**. This section is amended to include the following definitions:

LICENSE — The license issued by the City attesting that the rental unit has been properly registered in accordance with this chapter and may be occupied for rental purposes.

LICENSEE — The person to whom the license is issued pursuant to this chapter. The term includes within its definition the term "agent" where applicable.

§ 337-2. Registration. This section is amended to include § 337-2A., § 337-2B. and § 337-2C. as indicated below.

§ 337-2A. Rental unit license required.

No person shall rent, lease, provide or make available any rental unit to any person unless and until that rental unit is licensed by the Township of Riverside in accordance with this chapter.

§ 337-2B. License; time for application.

The record owner, or authorized agent of the record owner, of every rental unit shall apply for a license for each rental unit.

A. The initial application for existing rental units shall be filed on or before January 15, 2023.

B. Thereafter, a new application for each existing rental unit shall be filed by the 15th day of January in each year.

C. Following January 15, 2023, the record owner, or authorized agent for the record owner, shall apply for a license for each rental unit no later than the time of occupancy by the first tenant in any newly constructed, reconstructed or other newly created rental unit.

D. Upon the change of record of ownership of a rental unit premises, the new record owner shall apply for a new license for any rental unit.

§ 337-2C Term of license.

A. Each rental unit license shall expire and be void on January 15 of the calendar year following the calendar year in which the license was issued.

B. Each rental unit license shall expire and be void upon the change of record ownership of the rental unit premises.

C. A rental unit license shall become void, in the same manner as if it expired, upon revocation of the license in accordance with § 337-17 of this chapter.





§ 337-17. Violations and penalties. This section of the Township Code is hereby deleted and replaced with the following sections below.

§ 337-17. Revocation or suspension of license; procedure.

A. In addition to any other penalty prescribed herein, a rental unit license granted under this chapter may be subject to the revocation, suspension, fine and/or the imposition of special conditions, including but not limited to the installation/implementation of appropriate security measures, including physical facilities such as fencing, lighting, gating, etc., and/or deployment of security personnel, and including the requirement of the posting of a bond, letter of credit or other adequate security to ensure performance of any such conditions of the license issued hereunder upon the happening of one or more of the following:

- (1) A finding that there was any misstatement of material fact in the registration certificate upon which the license was issued.
- (2) The occurrence of any fact which, had it occurred and been known before issuance of the license, would have resulted in the denial of the application.
- (3) Repeated violations, or prolonged failure to correct any violation, of any applicable building, housing, health or safety code or regulations.
- (4) Permitting the rental unit to be occupied by more than the maximum number of occupants as defined herein.
- (5) Maintaining the rental unit or units or the property on which the rental unit is located in a dangerous condition likely to result in injury to persons or property.
- (6) If taxes or other assessments are delinquent for three consecutive quarters. Upon payment of such delinquent taxes or assessments, the license or permit shall be restored, upon new inspections for occupancy taking place.
- (7) Refusal to allow access to any portion of the licensed premises at all reasonable times, with or without advance notice, in order that officers or agents of the Township, or any official charged with enforcement of any building, housing, health or safety code or regulations applicable to the rental unit premises, may determine compliance with such codes or regulations.
- (8) Revocation by the Housing Office Inspector or Code Enforcement Officer of the operator's license or other authorization to operate, if the rental unit is a hotel, multiple dwelling or rooming or boarding house regulated by the State of New Jersey.
- (9) Notification by the Housing Office Inspector or Code Enforcement Officer, that the rental unit premises is not, or is no longer, suitable for operation, if the rental unit is a hotel, multiple dwelling, or rooming or boarding house regulated by the State of New Jersey.
- (10) Failure or refusal to comply with any lawful regulation or order of the Township.
- (11) Conviction of a violation of this chapter in the municipal court or any other court of competent jurisdiction.

- (12) Determination of a violation of this chapter at a hearing held pursuant to Subsection B hereafter following.
- (13) If in any twelve-month period on two separate occasions tenants of a residential unit and/or persons frequenting said unit with the permission or acquiescence of the tenant are convicted of offenses involving noisy, unruly or tumultuous behavior on or about the rental unit property, and/or otherwise attributable to the occupancy of the rental unit, and the landlord has not taken legal action to evict the tenants.
- (14) If, after a proper hearing on the matter, a determination is made that the licensee has not installed/implemented adequate security measures and the rental unit(s) or premises of which the rental unit(s) are a part, have required over the preceding 12 months repeated law enforcement response/intervention and/or been the location of more than one serious crime incident.
- B. Procedure, complaints, hearings.
- (1) A complaint seeking the revocation or suspension of a license may be filed by any person interested in the matter, or initiated directly by the Chief of Police, Housing Office or Code Enforcement Office. In the event that the complaint is initiated by a person other than the Housing Office, the complaint shall be referred to the Housing Office, who shall promptly review and investigate the matter. In the event that the Housing Office's investigation indicates that there is not sufficient evidence or probable cause to justify further proceedings, the Housing Office shall notify the complainant of such conclusion and the reasons therefor in writing, and the matter shall be concluded. In the event that the complaint is initiated directly by the Housing Office, or in the event that a third party complaint is investigated and the Housing Office determines that sufficient evident or probable cause exists, and therefore further proceedings are warranted, the Housing Office shall promptly consult with the Township Solicitor and provide a copy of the complaint and all materials associated therewith. If the Township Solicitor concurs with the Housing Office that further proceedings are justified, the Housing Office shall file the complaint with the Municipal Clerk.
- (2) Upon filing of such complaint with the Municipal Clerk, the Township Committee shall be immediately informed, and a date for a hearing shall be scheduled which shall not be sooner than 10 nor more than 30 days thereafter. The Municipal Clerk shall forward a copy of the complaint and a notice as to the date of the hearing to the licensee and the agent, if any, at the address indicated on the registration certificate by certified mail. Service upon the agent shall be sufficient.
- (3) The hearing required by this section shall be held before the Township Committee unless, in its discretion, the Township Committee determines that the matter should be heard by a Hearing Officer or Officers who shall be appointed by the Township Committee. If the matter is referred to a Hearing Officer, such Officer shall transmit his findings of fact and conclusions of law to the Township Committee within 30 days of the conclusion of the hearing. The Township Committee shall then review the matter and may accept, reject or modify the recommendations of the Hearing Officer based on the record before such Hearing Officer. In the event that the matter is not referred to a Hearing Officer and is heard by the Township Committee, then the Township Committee shall render a decision within 30 days of the conclusion of the hearing. Following the hearing, a decision





shall be rendered, dismissing the complaint, revoking or suspending the license, determining that the license shall not be renewed or reissued for one or more subsequent license years, or suspending or revoking the license unless the licensee pays a specified fine, posts financial security to reasonably ensure future compliance or abatement of the problem, or fulfills other requirements imposed as are appropriate under the circumstances.

- (4) At the hearing, witnesses shall be sworn prior to testifying. The strict rules of evidence shall not apply, and the evidential rules and burden of proof shall be that which generally control administrative hearings.
- (5) The Township Solicitor or his designee shall appear and prosecute on behalf of the complainant in all hearings conducted pursuant to this section.

§ 337-18. Violations and penalties.

A. Any person violating this chapter shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$2,000; or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding 90 days or by a period of community service not exceeding 90 days. Any person who is convicted of violating this chapter within one year of the date of a previous violation of the same chapter and who was fined for the previous violation, shall be sentenced by a court to an additional fine as a repeat offender. The additional fine imposed by a court upon a person for a repeated offense shall not be less than the minimum or exceed the maximum fine fixed for a violation of the chapter, but shall be calculated separately from the fine imposed for the violation of the chapter.

- B. Notwithstanding any penalty of the within section, any person violating the within section within six months of the date that any license becomes due shall have the option of paying the fine at the Riverside Municipal Clerk's Office, without the necessity of a Court appearance, subject to a violation schedule. To be permitted to pay the fine through the Clerk's Office of Riverside Township, the license fee on that applicable unit must be paid for the applicable year. The violation schedule shall be set forth as follows:
- (1) From February 1 of the calendar year that the license pursuant to §337-2A is past due through February 28 of that same calendar year the fine shall be payable through the Township Clerk's Office in the amount of \$20;
- (2) From March 1 of the calendar year that the license pursuant to §337-2A is past due through March 31 of that same calendar year the fine shall be payable through the Township Clerk's Office in the amount of \$40;
- (3) From April 1 of the calendar year that the license pursuant to §337-2A is past due through April 30 of that same calendar year the fine shall be payable through the Township Clerk's Office in the amount of \$60;
- (4) From May 1 of the calendar year that the license pursuant to §337-2A is past due through May 31 of that same calendar year the fine shall be payable through the Township Clerk's Office in the amount of \$80;

- (5) From June 1 of the calendar year that the license pursuant to §337-2A is past due through June 30 of that same calendar year the fine shall be payable through the Township Clerk's Office in the amount of \$100;
- (6) From July 1 of the calendar year that the license pursuant to §337-2A is past due through July 31 of that same calendar year the fine shall be payable through the Township Clerk's Office in the amount of \$120;
- C. Any license fee for any unit as defined in this section that is not paid by July 31 of the calendar year for which the license fee is due shall not be subject to the above schedule of violations, and shall be issued a special complaint and the matter shall be scheduled for a hearing in the Riverside Township Municipal Court subject to a fine not to exceed \$500 (per violation).

§ 337-19. Review process.

The Housing Office shall perform an annual review of the process regulated by this chapter. A written report shall be submitted to the Township Committee which shall include, but not limited to, the following information:

- A. Number of landlords registered.
- B. Compliance with this chapter.
- C. Suggestions for improvement and/or modifications of the regulations.

Also, any references found in Chapter 337 to § 212 shall be changed to § 337

Please accept this letter as a summary of the proceedings for the hearing conducted on October 28, 2024 at 2:00 pm with respect to the potential revocation or suspension of the license of Carlos Yunga. Ordinance # 2022-14, which amends Township Code §337, provides the process and standards for the hearing on the potential suspension or revocation of a rental unit license. See §337-17B. The hearing was conducted relating to the following rental properties located within Riverside Township:

210 Kossuth Street
709 Bridgeboro Road
728 Filmore Street
507 Bem Street
20 W. Hancock Street
224 E. Washington Avenue

Mr. Albert K. Marmero, Esq, the Township Solicitor, represented the Township at the hearing and presented evidence in the form of testimony by two witnesses, Kevin Johnson, the Code Enforcement Officer and Meghan Jack, the Township Administrator and one of the Township's Zoning officers. The proceedings occurred virtually and were recorded.

The Township also presented the following Exhibits which were marked and accepted into evidence at the hearing:

T-2: Ord 2022-14 - Code §337-2A and §337-17 (revocation or suspension of Landlord's license)

Opening Presentation by the Township

Mr. Marmero provided an overview of the testimony and evidence to be presented by the Township. He summarized the service made upon the Landlord, Carlos Yunga, in which the Township served him with a copy of the Complaint filed with the Municipal Clerk, Susan Dydek, RMC by letter dated August 19, 2024 with Exhibits, consisting of citations issued to Mr. Yunga ("the Landlord") relating to the subject properties. The Complaint filed with the Clerk by the Code Enforcement Officer stated the Township's intent to conduct a hearing consistent with the provisions of Ordinance #2022-14, on whether the Landlord's license to rent these properties should be suspended or revoked. The requested hearing under Ordinance #2022-14 provides the Landlord with procedural due process to oppose the allegations of the Complaint and as to the property rights of the Landlord which could be affected by the relief sought by the Township of either suspension or revocation of the Landlord's license to rent the properties.

On October 1, 2024, a letter with the Complaint was sent to Mr. Yunga at 507 Bem Street, Riverside, which is the mailing address used by Mr. Yunga on the Township's Landlord registration forms. The address had been used for various enforcement actions against Mr. Yunga brought in Municipal Court. Mr. Yunga was also served with notice of the Township's intent to conduct a hearing on the suspension or revocation of his license by serving the Letter with the Complaint by email on October 1, 2024.

It is noted that the initial notice or communication sought the input of both Mr. Yunga and the Hearing officer on dates and times for conducting the hearing and no response was received from Mr. Yunga despite sending several inquiries. The hearing was scheduled for Monday, October 28, 2024 and conducted by video conference on that date.

Prior to the hearing date, Mr. Yunga did not request that the hearing be conducted on a different day or time for the hearing and did not request an adjournment of the hearing. Mr. Yunga did not appear at the hearing on October 28, 2028, either personally or through an attorney representing his interests. As Mr. Yunga was not present for the hearing, there was no defense to the Township's testimony or any objection to any of the evidence presented. The landlord did not afford himself to the opportunity to provide a contrary version or an explanation for any of the alleged conditions of the various properties and the violations cited or the background provided by the Township in the testimony of its witnesses.

Evidence presented by the Township at the hearing

The Township's Code Enforcement Officer, Kevin Johnson, was sworn and provided factual testimony concerning the following properties:

210 Kossuth Street: The Landlord had renovated the property without the required Code

inspections, including that the rental property has been occupied without a Certificate of Habitability being issued in violation of §166-2(A). Mr. Johnson testified that the property failed certain inspection requirements, namely that the landlord had re-rented overcrowded the Municipal Court case on the violations remains open and unresolved. Mr. Johnson provided testimony that indicated that the landlord had failed to obtain the required permits for a change of use, that a prior plumbing connection to provide water service to the garage had been appropriately capped off because a garage could not be used for living space. However, the inspections of the property showed that Mr. Yunga acquired the garage and converted it into living space which was being used as a 1-bedroom apartment in violation of the Township's Code because the garage was converted without the required inspections and approvals. Mr. Yunga was cited for these violations in 2024 and failed to appear at the Municipal Court hearings. Mr. Johnson identified the documents within Exhibits T-1 and T-3 which referred to the conditions and Code violations issued for this property. Mr. Johnson testified that the property is being occupied with open violations, that no Certificate of Occupancy has been issued and that this violation poses a significant health and safety issue, and that the violation still has not been remediated.

Mr. Johnson testified that during a rental inspection and for a Certificate of Occupancy for the resale of 709 Bridgeboro Road, the inspection revealed that the property was being operated as a boarding house with locks on the doors to the different bedrooms in violation of the Township Code. Based upon these violations detected during the inspection, the locks were removed after inspection. Subsequent to the inspection, the Township Police Department was called to the property for a domestic violence issue. The officers noted that there were deadbolts on the bedroom doors at the property, in violation of the Township's Code. Mr. Johnson identified the documents within Exhibit T-1 which referred to the conditions based upon the inspection, and the Code violations issued for this property. He testified that the tenants at that property admitted to renting single rooms, which is a violation of the Code §266-22 prohibiting operating a rooming house. Mr. Johnson testified that while the property is finally in compliance but that the Landlord has not appeared in Municipal Court to address the offense.

728 Filmore Street: Mr. Johnson testified that during a rental inspection, he noted that a swimming pool had been installed without the required construction permits and that there was a shed which had been expanded without the required permits, but which was being used as a dwelling unit, in which Mr. Yunga admitted that he was living there. Mr. Johnson testified that the shed is not a habitable living area and that the occupancy of the shed as a dwelling area is not permitted. He testified that he issued a violation, with the date of the offense being 4-11-2024, but that to date, Mr. Yunga had failed to appear in Municipal Court for the violation. He testified that the violations consisted of a change in use for the accessory structure, namely, the expansion of the shed without the required approvals, but also that the property at 728 Filmore Street was over-crowded in that there were multiple families living in the house which is a Single-Family home. Mr. Johnson identified the documents within Exhibits T-1 and T-5 which referred to the conditions and Code violations issued for this property. It was noted that Exhibit T-5 had a violation issued 8.15.2023 which remained open. He also identified Exhibit T-6, the police report confirming that Mr. Yunga was living at the location and Exhibit T-7, a photo of the living area at the property.

507 Bem Street: Mr. Johnson identified Exhibit T-4 and described the conditions which led to his issuance of Code violations for this property. The property was issued a violation for

Cited for grass and debris on the property. He testified that the grass was overgrown, that debris and trash were piled in the front yard, that the violations had not been rectified. He testified that the landlord has not obtained a Certificate of Occupancy, and that the property has not been inspected and that someone had chickens on the site, which is not permitted.

Meghan Jack, the Township Administrator and one of the Township's Zoning officers, was also sworn and provided testimony. Ms. Jack provided testimony which confirmed the testimony of Mr. Johnson about the status of the various pending Municipal Court matters which the landlord had failed to address in that he continually sought adjournments of the hearings on the violations. Ms. Jack also provided testimony regarding the status of the landlord's failure to comply with the requirements of the Township Code with respect to the following rental properties:

20 W. Hancock Street: Ms. Jack testified that there are no open violations currently, that there had previously been violations which had been resolved, but that the Landlord was past the time frame for arranging for the Township to conduct its annual inspection of the property in 2024 consistent with the requirements of the Township Code for landlords to register and to provide access to the property for an inspection of the property to demonstrate that the property complies with the Township's Code and other requirements for rental properties. Ms. Jack testified that Landlords are required to register each rental property annually and also schedule an inspection. As of the date of the hearing, which occurred at the end of the tenth month of the year and therefore 10 months after the registration was due, the Landlord had still failed to comply with the inspection requirement of the Township Code for rental properties. She offered testimony that the refusal to allow access for periodic and/or annual inspections in violation of §337-8 and -9.

224 E. Washington Street: Ms. Jack testified that there are no open violations currently, that there had previously been violations which had been resolved, but that the Landlord was past the time frame for arranging for the Township to conduct its annual inspection of the property in 2024 consistent with the requirements of the Township Code for landlords to register and to provide access to the property for an inspection of the property to demonstrate that the property complies with the Township's Code and other requirements for rental properties.

Ms. Jack and Mr. Johnson testified that there have been persistent issues with the subject properties, that violations have been issued numerous times over the past 4-5 years. She testified that in some instances, after the violations are issued, Mr. Yunga will address the violation but then after a short period of compliance, when the properties are reinspected, the violations reoccur or new violations are issued for different non-conforming conditions or practices.

Mr. Marmero provided a summary of the testimony and evidence presented in support of the allegations in the Complaint that the landford, Mr. Yunga, had violated the provisions of the Ordinance, such that revocation of his license to rent these properties was warranted. Mr. Marmero noted that with respect to each of the properties, there was a repeated and prolonged failure to correct known violations which presented a real and present danger to the health and safety of the persons occupying these properties. He noted that several of the properties were being occupied by an excessive number of occupants (709 Bridgeboro Road and 728 Filmore Street). He also noted that several of the properties were being occupied despite the fact that the required Certificate of Occupancy had not been obtained or the required inspection sought (507 Bem; 208

Kossuth, 210 Kossuth), such that properties were clearly being rented without approval. Mr. Marmero submitted that the evidence provided by the Township clearly demonstrated that all of these properties were being maintained in a dangerous condition and likely to cause injury due to the over-crowding, the lack of compliance with the Code and the expansion of several of the units without the required technical (plumbing and other Sub-Code) approvals. He also noted that the landlord had violated §337-2A on a persistent basis in refusing to allow access to the properties for inspections, including the annual inspections. Mr. Marmero noted that the landlord had also violated Township Code §337-10, in that he had failed to promptly comply with orders by Township to bring the properties into compliance. While the Township conceded that there have been no findings by the Municipal Court adjudicating a violation for the various notices of violation issued, it is the Township's position that the landlord has simply been avoiding adjudication by failing or refusing to appear at the Municipal Court hearings.

Findings:

The procedure and standards in the Township Code as revised, provide that a landlord's license to rent properties may be suspended or revoked after conducting a hearing on notice to the landlord. See §337-17B. The Code provides that a rental unit license may be subject to revocation, suspension, fine or the imposition of special conditions (such as enhanced security measures or physical improvements to the property) in the event that certain events have occurred, as listed in §337-17A(1-14).

The reasons for suspending or revoking a rental unit license include the occurrence of any fact which, had it been known before the issuance of the license, would have resulted in the denial of the (rental unit) application. §337-17A(2). Certainly, had the excessive occupancy of rental units and operation of a unit as a boarding home been known, the Township would have denied the applications for 709 Bridgeboro Road and 728 Filmore Street, which is also contrary to §337-17A(4 and 5). §337-17A(3) provides that repeated violations or the prolonged failure to correct a violation also constitutes good cause for the special measures provided for in the Code

I find that the Landlord has been given sufficient notice of the hearing, with the initial notice being sent on August 19, 2024 and subsequent notices being submitted by certified mail and email on October 1, 2024, October 10, 2024, and October 11, 2024 for a hearing which was conducted on October 28, 2024. No requests were made for an adjournment or to conduct a hearing on another date or at a different time. Therefore, I find that the Township's notice to Mr. Yunga was sufficient for the purpose of providing jurisdiction to proceed with the hearing on the Complaint.

As to the six properties identified in the Complaint, and whether a violation of the Township's Code occurred, I find as follows:

210 Kossuth Street: The Township demonstrated that the property is being occupied with open violations; that no Certificate of Occupancy was issued and that the violations pose a significant health and safety issue which still has not been remediated. I also find that the Landlord has failed to comply with basic requirements of Township Code by failing to obtain the required permits and approvals prior to making physical changes to the property and renting it to tenants;

and has failed to comply with directives of the Township, including but not limited to the persistent failure to address open violations by appearing for scheduled hearings in Municipal Court.

709 Bridgeboro Road: The Township demonstrated that the property has been occupied over its permitted occupancy capacity; that no Certificate of Occupancy was issued and that the violations pose a significant health and safety issue in that the house was being operated as a boarding home with doors to separate bedrooms having locks on the outside of the doors, in violation of Code and constituting an emergent safety and fire hazard; that after being issued a violation and being directed to eliminate the clear housing Code violations, the Landlord gained compliance and then intentionally and surreptitiously reversed the abatement of the violation by re-installing the locks and continuing to operate the property as a boarding home.

728 Filmore Street: The Township demonstrated that the property is being maintained in a dangerous condition and likely to cause injury due to over-crowding, the lack of compliance with the Code and the expansion of use without the required technical (plumbing and other Sub-Code) permits and approval, including the installation of a pool, expansion of the use of a shed with plumbing and as an unauthorized living area.

507 Bem Street: The Township demonstrated that the landlord maintained a property in an unsafe, hazardous condition by failing to cut grass and allowing trash and debris to accumulate. In addition, the property is being occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy, as is required.

20 W. Hancock Street: The Township demonstrated that the Landlord has failed to comply with the inspection requirement of the Township Code for rental properties. The failure to arrange for or allow access to the unit to conduct the annual inspection violates §337-17A(7 and 10).

224 E. Washington Street: The Township demonstrated that the Landlord has failed to comply with the inspection requirement of the Township Code for rental properties. The failure to arrange for or allow access to the unit to conduct the annual inspection violates §337-17A(7 and 10).

The Code provides that a landlord's license to rent a unit or property may be suspended or revoked if the landlord has repeatedly failed to correct Code violations §337-17A(3); that there has been a prolonged failure to correct existing violations over a lengthy period of time; that the failure to correct the violations poses a danger to the health, safety and welfare of the public §337-17A(5); that the landlord has engaged in improper and/or unsafe rental practices such as renting properties for an excessive number of occupants, maintaining rental units in an unsafe condition, likely to cause injury. §337-17A(4 and 5) Although the Township has conceded that there has been no conviction of a violation adjudicated in the Municipal Court in violation of §337-17A(11), given the number of adjournments of the Court cases (which was not disputed by any evidence), it is apparent that the Landlord, Mr. Yunga, has been avoiding the adjudication of the violations in Municipal Court in an attempt to evade the imposition of fines or other penalties for the conditions of various rental units.

The Township's presentation was not disputed or contested as to the accuracy of the facts presented and there was nothing in the presentation which caused me to find that the facts and

evidence as presented were inaccurate or exaggerated in any fashion. To the contrary, the testimony and evidence presented indicated that the Township has been quite measured and fair to Mr. Yunga and has attempted for several years to gain his cooperation and compliance with the important health and safety requirements of the Township's Code relating to standards for rental properties. The Township demonstrated that none of the violations noted have been disputed by Mr. Yunga or disproved in any fashion. In addition, the evidence submitted by the Township demonstrated that he has failed or refused on a persistent basis to comply with reasonable directives, including the requirement to provide timely access for annual inspections of the rental properties and to obtain the required Certificate of Occupancy. In addition, I note that in the face of numerous notices of potential Code violations were not abated and resulted in the Township's Code Enforcement Officer filing Complaints to be heard and adjudicated in Municipal Court, Mr Yunga has steadfastly failed or refused to appear for multiple hearings in Municipal Court to defend, resolve or to otherwise adjudicate numerous pending violations on multiple properties. In making this observation and finding, I relied not only on the testimony of Mr. Johnson and Ms. Jack as to the persistence and duration of the non-compliance, but also on the Exhibits presented, consisting of Court notices, dating back to several months and even more than a year ago. See, for example, Exhibit T-1the notice for 210 Kossuth Street issued 09/06/23 for an offense date of 08/24/23; See also, the notice for 709 Bridgeboro Road issued 11/09/23 for an offense date of 11/08/23.

Based upon the totality of the circumstances, it is my finding that the landlord, Carlos Yunga, violated Ordinance #2022-14 as to each of the six (6) subject properties (210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street and 224 E. Washington Avenue). It is also my finding that the violations are pervasive, affecting the health, safety and welfare of the public, and that the Township's Code Enforcement and Zoning officers have made ongoing attempts over a significant period of time to gain the landlord's compliance with the violations; that despite their best efforts, the landlord/property owner, Mr. Yunga, has failed and/or refused to bring multiple properties into compliance; the landlord/property owner, Mr. Yunga has also failed and/or refused to adjudicate outstanding violations in Municipal Court, many of which remain open for seven or more months to more than one year. It is therefore recommended that the penalty for the repeated violations of the Township Code with respect to the properties owned by the subject landlord, Carlos Yunga, with respect to the properties at 210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street and 224 E. Washington Avenue, is that the license of Carlos Yunga to rent these properties should be revoked.

In addition, pursuant to the provisions and authority of the Code, §337-18(A), a person found to have violated this chapter may be subject to a fine. It appears that the Ordinance provides that the hearing process includes the adjudication of potential fines. It is recommended that a <u>fine</u> of <u>\$2000</u> for each of the six properties or rental units (210 Kossuth Street, 709 Bridgeboro Road, 728 Filmore Street, 507 Bem Street, 20 W. Hancock Street and 224 E. Washington Avenue) be assessed against Mr. Yunga. This fine is recommended due to the following reasons, which are consistent with the Code:

- The ongoing non-compliance of the landlord in failing to remediate the numerous violations cited;
- The failure to provide access to rental units;
