

**Township of Riverside
Notice and Certification of Pending Ordinances**

These Ordinances, the summaries and terms of which are included herein, were introduced and passed upon first readings at a Regular Meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Riverside, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, on February 23, 2026. These Ordinances will be further considered for final passage, after public hearings thereon, at a meeting of the Governing Body to be held at the Riverside Township Municipal Building, 1 W. Scott Street in the Township of Riverside on March 16, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full Ordinances will be available at no cost and during the regular business hours at the Municipal Clerk's Office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summaries and terms of such Ordinance are as follows **Title: 2026 - #2 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVERSIDE, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP'S LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS GOVERNING SOBER-LIVING AND RECOVERY RESIDENCES"** Purpose: This Ordinance regulates, amends and/or supplements Chapter 255 to distinguish between Oxford House style recovery homes that operate as self-governed households and staff-supervised CSLRs subject to DCA oversight, and to establish reasonable land-use standards consistent with federal and state laws. **Title: 2026 - #3 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 419 OF THE CODES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVERSIDE ENTITLED, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"** Purpose: This Ordinance amends schedules I, II, III, IV, V, XII, XVI, XVIII of Chapter 419 of the Codes of the Township of Riverside regulating Vehicles and Traffic.
